ARTICLE I

Dog Control Officers

[Adopted 4-25-2012 by L.L. No. 1-2012]

§ 39-1. Legislative authority.

This article is enacted pursuant to the authority of Chapter 365 of the Laws of 1976 which added a new subparagraph (3) to paragraph d of subdivision 1 of § 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law authorizing towns to adopt a local law which may amend or supersede any provision of the Town Law in relation to the property, affairs or government of the Town or in relation to any of the other enumerated subject matters in such § 10, unless there is a state legislative restriction on such amendment or supersession.

§ 39-2. Eligibility of Dog Control Officer and Deputy Dog Control Officer.

Section 23 of the Town Law is hereby amended and superseded in its application to the Town of Conklin to provide that the Dog Control Officer of the Town of Conklin and the Deputy Dog Control Officer of the Town of Conklin, at the time of their respective appointments and throughout their respective terms of office, need not be electors of the Town of Conklin so long as they are resident of the County of Broome of the State of New York. Two new sentences are hereby inserted at the end of § 23 of the Town Law to read and provide as follows: "The Dog Control Officer of the Town of Conklin, at the time of his appointment and throughout his term of office, need not be an elector of the Town of Conklin so long as he is a resident; of the County of Broome of the State of New York. The Deputy Dog Control Officer of the Town of Conklin, at the time of his appointment and throughout his term of office, need not be an elector of the Town of Conklin so long as he is a resident of the County of Broome of the State of New York.
